

Town of Jump River held its annual budget hearing on November 18th at 6:45pm.

Discussion was had regarding the amount that we are going to give to the fire department due to the increase request. It was approved that we will give the fire department the \$10,000 that they requested. The extra funds will come with an increase to the local levy under the fire protection clause in the amount of \$7500.

Patti made a motion to approve the budget as presented with a 2nd by Gary.

We then moved into our regular board meeting board members present were Myron, Gary, Patti, Karen and Denise.

Gary made a motion to approve the agenda as presented with a 2nd by Patti.

Secretaries' report was read. Patti made a motion to approve with the change to the beaver trapping with a 2nd by Gary.

Treasurers' report beginning balance was \$3,8379.20 with deposits of \$22,373.25 and bills of \$8,299.18 leaving and ending balance of \$52,453.27. Patti made a motion to approve the treasurers' report as presented with a 2nd by Gary.
