Old business

1. Snow plowing bids were opened.
 - a. Gary made a motion to give the snow plowing bid for the community center and fire hall to Trent Ahlers. We will have him come out after it snow's 2 inches or more. Myron will get in touch with Trent as to what the town's expectation are.
 - b. Patti made a motion to award the snow plowing of the town roads to AMCO LLC. Myron will get ahold of Arlen and go over things also. We will continue to go with the 3 inch rule.
2. Adopt 2019 Budget
 - a. Patti made a motion to adopt the 2019 budget with the local levy limit of \$34,068.00. Gary 2nd.
3. Park
 - a. Water sample came back good. Denise sent a copy of the report to Tony at the county. Denise has also been in contact with the McVickers as they are finishing up the markers for the campsites. They almost have them completed and they have also made entrance signs.

New Business

1. Emergency Management update-the county is working on a manual with names and contacts for each township in case of an emergency or disaster of some sort. Gary is working on this committee.
2. Ball Park-Myron will be working on trying to get some money from the county to help do some repairs and improvements down by the ball park. Such as dug outs, back stops and possibly new fencing. Myron will work on writing up a resolutions and bring it back to the next meeting.
