Supervisors report

1. Emery took a trip around the town roads he mentioned that the worst road was near Tiny McVickers and by Wrights, and Venus.
2. The bridge next to Lil Zach's needs to be looked at for possible replacement
3. Emery also mentioned that there is also grant money available for roads

Road Work/updates

1. There is a logger working on Miller Road they have made contact with the town and we will work with them during break up. At this time the road is holding up and is still in good standing.
