Carolyn is taking care of making all the adjustments and getting documentation to the state. She also wanted to know what we as a town would like to do with this grant program. We have approximately \$15000 in the fund currently and she is looking for a recommendation from the town as to how we want to move forward. We asked her to get information together as to what is outstanding and what some of our options are. We as a town will promote these funds if we know anyone needing any home repairs that would qualify for this program. Information table in the community center.

- 1. Myron, Patti, and Denise went to the District meeting in Eau Claire. We competed our Board of review training for the next 2 years. It was expressed that this was one of the better meetings that they have had in a while. Myron talked a little on the Cyber Security.
- 2. Town Association meeting Myron let us know that the state reimbursed the towns that did not use all there road aid money.
